

EMERGENCY NURSING SERVICES

Emergency Nursing Services shall be made available to all Stanley-Boyd School District Students.

Leadership and supervision for the emergency nursing service will be provided by the registered nurse designated by Chippewa County Public Health. A written agreement between Chippewa County Public Health as well as other specified policy provisions has been to implement the intent of standard “g”.

Emergency Nursing Services is the providing of or provisions for immediate care needed to protect the health or enhance survival chances of the injured or acutely ill and for administering necessary medications.

Responsibility for providing Emergency Nursing Services may be delegated to other qualified personnel by the registered nurse.

An annual Emergency Nursing Services training review session will be provided for all school staff to instill or insure each staff member has a working knowledge of emergency care procedures and the ability to institute provisions thereof.

School staff will be provided information on all students requiring special health considerations.

Emergency Nursing Services shall be available during the regular school day and at all curricular and co-curricular student activities.
