## VEHICLE USAGE

This rule is intended to streamline the usage of school vehicles to reduce wear and tear on high cost vehicles and to maximize fuel economy. The vehicle assigned will be determined by the total number of people being transported and the availability of vehicles and/or drivers.

| School Bus | Recommended for Grades PK - 3rd | 3 to a seat | 72 |
|  | Recommended for Grades 4-12 | 2 to a seat | 48 |
| Lift Bus | Recommended for Grades PK - 3rd | 3 to a seat | 54 |
|  | Recommended for Grades 4-12 | 2 to a seat | 36 |
| Van | Cargo container available upon request. Extra drivers can be obtained for you upon request. | 1 driver/9 passengers | 10 |
| SUV |  | 1 driver/7 passengers | 8 |
| Pickup |  | 1 driver/4 passengers | 5 |
| Car |  | 1 driver/3 passengers | 4 |

Guidelines to use when planning your event / trip:

- 4 people or less including the driver will use the car.
- 10 people or less including the driver will use a van.
- 20 people or less including the driver will use two vans. Request additional driver if needed.
- 30 people or less including the driver will use three vans. Request additional driver(s) if needed.
- Pick-up used when large items need to be transported.
- SUV used when a car or van is not available.
- School buses may be used if van drivers are not available.
