Wisconsin's rule for identifying students with specific learning disabilities (SLD) has changed. No later than December 1, 2013, all initial SLD evaluations of public school students will use information from interventions to make eligibility decisions.

This posting is to notify you that beginning on December 1, 2013 initial SLD evaluations at Stanley-Boyd School District will begin using information from a student's response to intensive, scientific research based or evidence based interventions when making special education eligibility decisions.
