Student Responsibilities

I _____ agree to attend classes at Open Doors Academy beginning on, _____ (Date) from _____ (Days/Times). This contract is valid from _____ to _____. The student agrees to cooperate with the school and Open Doors Academy in implementing his/her educational program and not to be a disruptive influence within Open Doors Academy and/or upon the other students within the program.

The student agrees that he/she will attend classes during the contracted hours that Open Doors Academy have contracted for through the ODAP (Open Doors Academic Plan) until the student : a) graduates from high school; b) Is excused from school attendance by the School Board under WI Statute 118.15; c) Leaves school voluntarily at the end of the semester in which he/she turns 18; or d) Earns a High School Equivalency or Diploma (H.S.E.D.) The student agrees to cooperate with the school and Open Doors Academy in implementing his/her educational program and not to be a disruptive influence within Open Doors Academy and/or upon the other students within the program.

Program Structure

- The Stanley-Boyd Area School District has the authority to determine the times and days students will be attendance at Open Doors Academy.
- Students attending Open Doors Academy are permitted to participate in extra-curricular activities (athletics, clubs, dances, etc.) following the guidelines outlined in the Stanley-Boyd Student Handbook.
- It is understood by the students and parent/guardian that when a student volunteers to enter Open Doors Academy to pursue a High School diploma, they will not be allowed to return to traditional school (8:15 a.m.-3:30 p.m.) without approval from the High School Principal of Stanley Boyd High School. An ODAP and credit review will be provided to the student and parent/guardian explaining the student’s credits, behavioral, and academic modifications from the traditional high school diploma tract.
- It is understood by student and parent/guardian that the Stanley-Boyd Handbook used by the traditional 8:15-3:30 school will be followed by students of the Open Doors Academy, unless otherwise stated. This includes policies for conduct, student investigation, alcohol, tobacco and other drug possession.
