PROGRAMS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

If limited English speaking students are enrolled in the Stanley-Boyd Area Schools, the District is required to identify those students and assess individually their levels of proficiency in English. If this testing indicates that a student is of limited English speaking proficiency, the District shall develop an individual plan for the student providing for educational alternatives specific to that student's needs.

The District will also comply with the following notification process:

- 1. Notify the student's parents or guardian in writing regarding the student's inclusion in a testing program or alternative program. The notice shall be provided in English and in the parent's native language. The District shall use whatever means necessary to ensure that communication has been made with the parents or guardian.
- 2. Provide a written report of each student's test results and or alternative program to the student's parent or guardian. The report shall be provided in English and in the parent's native language. The District shall use whatever means of communication necessary to ensure that the parent or guardian understands this information.
