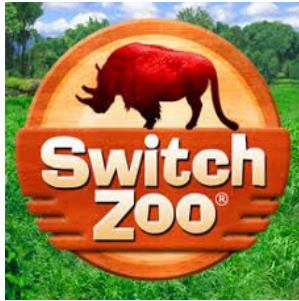
**Funbrain**


