## STUDENT CONDUCT

All student behavior should be based on respect and consideration for the rights of others. Students have a responsibility to know and follow the rules and regulations of the school.

Students shall conduct themselves in keeping with their level of maturity, acting with due regard for the supervisory authority vested by the Board in all district employees, for the educational purpose underlying all school activities and for the widely shared use of school property.

Students are expected to abide by the code of conduct and behavior as outlined in the student handbook, and / or as stated in the rules and regulations established by building principals for each school.

All employees shall share responsibility for supervising the behavior of students and for seeing that they meet the standards of conduct established by the building principal. In enforcing rules for student conduct, staff members shall place particular emphasis upon educating students in the ability to control themselves.

The School District shall not discriminate in standards of rules of behavior, including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.
