Foodservice will end meal delivery this Friday, June 5. Our kitchen will be closed next week but we will resume providing food for pickup on Wednesday, June 17. We will provide food at no cost to students for an entire week at a time. This food will be available for pickup Wednesdays at the High School from 10:30 AM to Noon. This program will run until the end of July. Families can sign up on the district website.

Our buildings and grounds are still closed for instruction and extra-curricular activities until June 30. Although we are closed, our buildings will be accessible June 8-12<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM to return materials and pick up student personal belongings. Building Principals should have specific plans for students on how to best enter and exit the buildings.

Summer school will run in July in a virtual format. More information will be sent out at a later time with specifics. If we are allowed to have student instruction in our buildings in July, we may add small group activities. At this time, we do not know what extra-curricular activities will look like in July or August. We will send out additional information when it becomes available.
